Footnotes

VIRGINIA ROYAL broke in, rated close about the three path, challenged nearing the three eighths pole, took over two deep approaching the quarter, drew clear midway on the final turn and dug in through the lane to repulse all challengers. HARRINGTON HARBOR, a step slow, was pinched at the break, settled well back outside, bid leaving the three eighths pole, rounded the final turn six wide, took place inside the sixteenth pole and finished evenly at the outside flank of the winner. LITTLE EDDIE settled off the pace outside, bid leaving the half mile pole, held close aim four wide on the final turn, leveled off in the lane and just lasted for show. C R CASE'S MONSTER, well off the pace in the three and four paths, bid near the rail at the five sixteenths pole, angled five wide leaving the final turn and just missed show in an even finish. INDISPENSABLE rated close to the early pace off the rail, raced boxed in rounding the first turn and again approaching the five sixteenths pole, resumed his drive past the pole, had aim into the lane but weakened the final sixteenth. KEVIN'SGOTAPRIZE, off the pace inside, picked off the chase nearing the five sixteenths pole, was blocked behind a wall of horses most of the final turn, eased to the seven path into the lane but had little left. SUTAI WINDY, edgy in the gate, kept close to the early pace about the three and four paths, challenged from the five sixteenths pole and held close aim three wide on the final turn before weakening. I'M NOT QUIET was no factor while saving ground. BOPPIN rated a short lead inside, came under pressure from the three eighths pole, was caught toward the quarter then faded closest to the rail rounding the final turn. SAILAWAY rated off the pace off the rail then faded after a half mile.
