THE URUGAUCHA tracked the pace under urging, moved three wide to command into the lane, eagerly kicked clear nearing the sixteenth pole and maintained a safe margin under left handed pressure. KYLA'S HARMONY , sluggish from the gate, was taken five wide soon after, advanced four wide into the lane and finished up with good energy to steadily gain. FAVORITE PRINCESS chased the pace while saving ground, eased out near the sixteenth marker but lacked a solid bid. PYRAMIDRIVE sprinted clear early, set the pace inside, was collared nearing the stretch, gave little resistance and weakened late. SO SERENE , between rivals early, dropped to the rail around the turn, angled out three wide nearing the stretch and finished up with belated interest. ORMA SHARP chased off the rail, angled in through the drive and faded. OBAMA GIRL raced without a whip, lacked speed, circled five wide into the stretch but failed to generate a solid run. VIRGINIA HARBOUR saved ground without a response. SET SAIL , hustled along four wide down the backstretch, failed to keep pace.
