**Footnotes**

T. M.'S TREASURE bobbled outward at the break and bumped with HOUSEHUNTER, settled back early while saving ground, gathered momentum along the rail around the far turn, continued a rail advance into the lane, shifted out to about the four path in upper stretch, closed relentlessly under stiff left handed encouragement and got up at the wire. HOUSEHUNTER bumped at the break, attended the pace while saving ground, moved inside DISCO DIVA to put a head in front with three furlongs remaining, edged clear leaving the quarter pole, kicked well clear nearing the stretch but failed to last. DANCINGINTHECITY, off the rail chasing the pace, angled in for the drive and rallied mildly. DISCO DIVA set the early pace two wide, briefly went clear past the half mile pole, was joined from the inside approaching the three eighths marker, chased HOUSEHUNTER into the lane then went evenly through the final furlong. MY WILDEST DREAMS, taken to rate early, saved ground leaving the far turn, angled out for the drive but came up empty. WATERSIDE ROSE, far back for five furlongs, angled wide and had a belated gain. FIVEFIFTYFIVE broke a step slow, was hustled up wide soon after, lost ground four wide past the half mile pole, angled in around the final turn but failed to threaten. VIOLET CIRCLE lost ground four wide to the eighth pole. PHARMTRIP rushed up between rivals under the wire the first time, stalked the leaders three wide then faltered after four and a half furlongs.
