### Footnotes

ROMANTIC CUVEE prompted the pace outside ALWAYSACONTEST, moved to command approaching the stretch and edged away under a drive. ASPETUCK HILL, between rivals early, chased the pace along the rail leaving the far turn, eased out for the drive, raced between foes near the sixteenth marker and finished gamely to earn the place. SPRING JUMP, four wide the first turn, raced within range three wide the far turn, chased the leaders past the three sixteenth marker then hung in the final yards. ALWAYSACONTEST sprinted clear early, set a rated pace, was hounded by the winner leaving the three eighths pole, briefly edged back clear near the quarter pole, relinquished command nearing the stretch and tired a sixteenth out. GIN SWEEP bumped repeatedly with FULL MOON BLUES nearing the first turn, raced three wide past the five eighths pole, made a slight advance between foes nearing the three sixteenths marker then lacked any further response. NORTH FREEWAY broke outward while a bit rank, steadied when attempting to get out nearing the first turn, dropped back to last, saved ground into the far turn and failed to recover. FULL MOON BLUES was roughed up when exchanging bumps into the first turn, angled wide and dropped back.
