BLYTHEWOOD well placed on the rail, angled out for the drive, gained the lead in late stretch and drove clear. ELUSIVE ASHLEE pressed the pace just off the rail, lacked a closing bid. STAMFORD BRIDGE set the pace on the rail, led until late stretch but was out finished. T. V. SECRETARY rallied along the rail down the backstretch and around the turn, made a mild gain through the stretch. DIANA MOSELEY stalked the pace five wide along the backstretch, came three wide on the turn, finished willingly. VERSATILES SECRET off a step slow, moved up three and four wide, lacked a late bid. DEFRILLS forced the pace four wide, lacked the needed late rally. SQUEEZ BLOSSOM with the pace five wide for a half, had little left for the drive. JADA JING showed little, three and four wide. MISS NINE'S WILD flashed early speed, stopped.
