WATERSIDE ROSE rated off the pace about the three path, started a four wide drive toward the quarter pole and dug in from the head of the lane to take over the final yards. HOLY STONE stalked the pace two deep, gave close chase through the final turn, dug in at the pacesetters' withers in the upper stretch and while besting that one to place, was outfinished for the win. MISS LOTAWATA rated a short lead inside, was pressured toward the quarter pole, dueled into the stretch then weakened passing the sixteenth pole. MISS DREW, off the pace off the rail, closed toward contention three wide on the final turn, angled inward in the upper stretch but had nothing left. SHE HAS ATTITUDE was boxed at the rail from the five eighths pole to the half mile pole, settled evenly down the backstretch then faded on the final turn. FLYING SPIRIT came away a step slow and was not a factor, as was CAMDEN'S DREAM no factor, and DEADLINE TIME was also not a factor.
