MISTER FIPS (IRE) prompted the pace while saving ground, lodged a bid inside PREAKNESS LAUGHER three furlongs out, dueled leaving the far turn, kicked clear nearing the stretch while two wide, responded to strong handling and prevailed. MR. ZULU , unhurried early while saving ground off of a solid early pace, commenced a run leaving the three sixteenths marker, continued along the rail into and through the lane and closed gamely inside the winner to just miss. SPORTY BOY broke slowly, was used up wide into the first turn to reach contention, advanced four wide leaving the far turn to loom a solid threat but could sustain through the drive. PARADO saved ground in mid pack while unhurried, angled out five wide for the drive and rallied mildly. PREAKNESS LAUGHER hopped at the break to be away towards the back, quickly recovered and rushed up between rivals to take command, edged clear around the first turn and set the pace two wide, was joined three furlongs out, dueled outside the winner past the quarter pole, forced the issue under a strong ride into the lane then faded. FORTUNATELY BOLD lacked speed, raced six wide into the stretch and passed tiring rivals. BIDEN OUR TIME , three wide chasing the pace, gave way after five furlongs. BEAU AMERICAN , four to five wide down the backstretch, dropped back.
