VAGUE NOTION steadily moved up three and four wide, gained the lead in late stretch and drove clear. SANTEE DEVIL pressed the issue three wide, had aim at the top of the lane but was out finished. BANK ROBYN RAY set the pace under heavy pressure, dug in around the turn but weakened in the drive. COTTON HEARTED four wide down the backstretch, dropped to the rail on the turn, lacked a late response. ANASAZI broke awkwardly, only passed tired ones four wide. DAJEM with the leaders three and four wide, tired. PAYINGHISDUE'S five wide along the backstretch, failed to menace. WADA ZANY DAY stopped after a half along the rail.
