Footnotes

SAINT ZITA, unhurried early, closed to contention outside down the backstretch, dueled three wide on the final turn and dug in through the stretch to get up late yards. VICARIOUS MOON rated back off the rail, bid saving ground leaving the five sixteenths pole, eased out through the stretch and finished well four wide. OLE ROCKY TOP was urged clear for inside position, rated a short lead down the backstretch, contested the rail rounding the final turn, drew clear into the lane but weakened in later yards. KELA'S PRIDE stalked the pace off the rail, took the lead three wide past the three eighths pole, contested between horses rounding the final turn then leveled off in the stretch. RITEPLACE RITETIME raced with the early pace two deep, took a brief slim lead nearing the three eighths pole though lacked further on the final turn. FLEET SPECIAL was not a factor while saving ground. SPRINGTIME FROLIC became fractious unseating her rider in the gate and was through early.
