Footnotes

LIVELY REPARATIONS settled inside early, angled out four wide leaving the half mile marker, commenced his run leaving the far turn, closed steadily under right handed pressure, collared STREET SWAGGER leaving the sixteenth marker and kicked clear. STREET SWAGGER was angled to the rail nearing the first turn to gain a good position, eased back out to the three path a half mile out, moved to command approaching the three eighths pole, went clear nearing the far turn while under some urging, came under a strong ride into the lane, drifted out some when clear near the sixteenth pole then gave way grudgingly. DESERT TIGER came out at the break, was straightened away and moved up three to four wide to stalk the pace, edged closer into the far turn, chased the leader into the stretch, loomed inside the eighth pole then flattened out. GREEN SPRING BOY, bumped at the break, was outrun early, came four wide for the drive and had some belated action. OUTSMARTING DIXIE saved ground chasing the pace, made a slight advance mid way on the final turn then came up empty. SEA RESCUE, bumped at the break, lagged back off the rail, circled five wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. MR. BALLISTIC sprinted clear early, set the pace towards the inside, was headed nearing the three eighths pole, chased the leader around the turn and gave way in upper stretch. MAD LOUIE was used four wide into the first turn chasing the pace and dropped back after a half mile. JUDGE PRIEST forced the early pace three wide and tired. SHERIFF ERIC was bumped and in tight at the break, lagged back, saved ground into the lane and never had a response.
