MR. SKAGGS pressed the issue just off the rail, gained the lead in mid stretch and drew off. SCALPER set the pace under heavy pressure, led until mid stretch. TANKS HOMEWRECKER advanced three and four wide, lacked a closing bid. SECRET'S FUTURE moved up along the inside, lacked a late response. JORKAT SLEW tardy at the start, passed tiring rivals five wide. JUDGE MARSHALL forced the leaders three wide, lacked the needed late rally. SIMBA CAT with the pace three and four wide, tired. BULLET DANCER never threatened, three and four wide. T K O MILES alternated on the lead for a half, gave way around the turn then was not abused through the stretch.
