TWO DRAGONS kept three wide setting the pace, was all out to last. NOT A GENTLEMAN forced the issue three and four wide, finished strongly. GRAMERCY PARK advanced three wide, lacked a closing bid. CASTLE BULL prompted the pace between horses, lacked a late response. JUDGE MARSHALL pressed the issue from the rail, lacked the needed rally. WOODWORKER failed to menace, three wide. LORD WILLING stalked the pace from the inside, failed to respond. RED STEEDE never threatened, five wide. STILL THE ONE was used up after a half along the inside. DIXIEBAND DESTINY a pace factor four wide, lacked a late bid.
