**Footnotes**

COOPER COUNTY rated close in the three path, took aim leaving the three eighths pole, pressured the pacesetter through the final turn, dueled to the front midstretch, drew clear and lasted well under steady encouragement. BAY BUTTON BILL settled off the pace three wide, bid nearing the quarter pole, saved ground through the final turn, eased back to the three path for the drive home and finished evenly for place. SIR JOHN moved to the lead four wide near the nine sixteenths pole, rated the pace inside through the backstretch, was pressured from the quarter pole, yielded toward the sixteenth and leveled off from there. DECOLATOR settled back off the rail, saved ground through the final turn and finished evenly. LAC VALENTINE, shuffled back early, showed no speed toward mid track, swung seven wide into the stretch and had no rally. SHAMSS was rated back inside and had no rally. THREE POINT TICKET, off the early pace in the four path, gave chase through the backstretch, entered the stretch six wide then weakened. THAT'S RICH stalked the pace two deep on the backstretch though had no further response on the final turn. PREACHIN HEAT was not a factor.
