Footnotes

LOADS OF FUN , checked in tight quarters between horses leaving the backstretch, was four wide leaving the turn, closed strongly and was up in time. MO MO TOBIN disputed the pace outside DOUBLE SHOT and weakened late. BIG RED RIVER bore in leaving the starting gate and rallied in the two path between horses. SMOKIN CANOE chased the pace three wide around the turn and came up empty late. DOUBLE SHOT hugged the rail, disputed the pace to midstretch then gave way. LAST HEART broke slowly, came into the stretch very wide, raced on his left lead and finished with interest. MURPHY'S BEST saved ground and was outrun. STURM AND DRANG , forced in leaving the starting gate, saved ground, chased the pace and weakened on the turn. GIBSON'S ATTITUDE , rank leaving the starting gate, raced very wide on the turn and was outrun.
