Footnotes

SUPER JORDAN settled off the pace toward the outside, bid from the five sixteenths pole, rounded the final turn in the three path, dueled to the lead inside the sixteenth pole and edged clear approaching the wire. ROCKY TWIST stumbled leaving the gate, rated close off the rail, started his bid past the three eighths pole, took the lead nearing the head of the stretch but was caught a sixteenth away and gave way to the winner from there. PROPER MOVE, forced out entering the first turn, settled well back from the early pace off the rail, started a bid at the three eighths pole, steadily improved near the rail rounding the final turn, eased to the three path into the lane, was unsaddled on the turn, appeared sore and vanned home. BANNER YIELD stalked the early pace two deep, took the lead at the seven sixteenths pole, was under a drive a furlong later then caught nearing the head of the lane and weakened from there. ARE YOU HAPPY TOO held a short lead inside to the seven sixteenths pole, brushed the rail past the three eighths, recovered stride to give chase nearing the final turn but leveled off down the lane. STOP THE BULL drifted outward into the first turn, raced well back toward mid track and had no response from the three eighths pole. NIK'S STAR CHOICE saved ground well back. MR. B. H. TINKLE stalked the early pace about the four path, gave chase from the half mile pole then faded on the final turn. FAITHFUL SINNER ducked in at the break, stayed off the early pace inside then faded after a half mile.
