**Footnotes**

CURLY HALO pressed the pace from just off the rail, moved clear around the turn, drew off through the stretch under a drive. POPULAR BLUES bumped at the start, forced the pace three wide but was no threat to the winner while second best. HIPS AND HAWS set the early pace on the rail, kept pace along the backstretch, lacked a late bid. COZY'S MINT JULIP rallied five wide around the turn but lacked a closing bid. GOLD BUTTER lunged at the start then bumped with both POPULAR BLUES and SILVER BUTTONS, passed tiring rivals three wide. SUAVE PRINCESS showed early speed, raced in mid pack thereafter while lacking the needed rally. SILVER BUTTONS bumped at the start, ranged up three wide but flattened out. LAUREN'S TOUR was no factor four wide. SKIT was used up after a half along the inside. HINDSIGHT saved ground to no avail.
