HE'S THE KING bumped with WHAT A WILDCAT leaving the starting gate, assumed the early lead, set the pace along the rail and lasted. POLITICAL CHIEF broke awkwardly, was steadied soon after the break, circled horses and rallied. POWER PRINTS , unhurried early, chased the pace outside the winner and gave way leaving the far turn. MICKEYTHEPREACHER saved ground and weakened. DIXIE THIEF , outrun, passed tired foes. WHAT A WILDCAT bumped with the winner leaving the starting gate and failed to be a factor. SWINGING SCOOTER broke slowly, raced wide around the far turn and was outrun. FRISKY ALSO , no factor, was vanned off. COLONEL GRAND chased the pace three wide and faltered on the far turn. NO COLLEEN , three wide the first turn, was finished on the far turn.
