DOWN TOWN ALLEN moved up quickly to take a slim lead down the backstretch, drew off around the turn and prevailed while kept to urging through the stretch. WHERE'S GINGER broke alertly and dropped down to the inside to be outside the winner along the backstretch, could not gain on that one while second best. AMY'S AFFAIR steadied shortly after the start, advanced three and four wide but could not gain on the top two in the drive. SUGARPLUMFAIRY within striking distance three wide down the backstretch, lacked the needed late rally when asked in the lane. SILVER CUB saved ground, tried to rally four wide around the turn but failed to respond in the stretch. SALUSHKA flashed early speed along the inside then steadily faded. The rider of AMY'S AFFAIR lodged a claim of foul against the rider of WHERE'S GINGER alleging interference at the start. Following a review of the video tape replays the Stewards disqualified WHERE'S GINGER from second and placed him third.
