COLONEL J W tardy at the start, was five wide into and out the first turn, settled down to be three wide along the backstretch, gained a clear lead into the stretch and drew off under intermittent urging. PRIDE OF MARY shuffled back down the backstretch along the inside, angled out some for the drive and was second best late. TROUBLE MAKIN set the pace while under pressure, gave way to the winner on the turn and settled for the place late. EL NUMERO UNO saved ground, advanced four wide down the backstretch, came wider into the stretch and lacked a closing bid. COVER MY SIX within striking distance along the inside, lacked the needed late rally. CAMDEN WOOD off a step slow, was a pace factor for a half, lacked a closing bid. I'M FUHR REAL with the leaders three and four wide, fell back around the turn. BEST TO GO WEST sluggish at the start, failed to menace three wide. SPEEDY TUXEDO stopped after a half, inside.
