TEN LUCKY STARS pressed the issue just of the rail, drew off around the turn then widened through the stretch while under urging. GANGA stalked the leaders from the inside, bid on the turn an was second best. DAPPER DANE set the pace under heavy pressure, weakened in the drive. KEEP YOUR HAT ON advanced three and four wide, failed to sustain his bid. GRAVELITO forced the issue from the rail, lacked the needed rally. NATIVE WON WAQUOIT prompted the pace four wide, tired. DEVON VENTURE made little impact on the rail. BIG BOOM AFFAIR sluggish at the start, trailed throughout.
