ROCKY MARSH saved ground well off the pace, started a bid nearing the three eighths pole, eased outward through the final turn, entered the stretch in the seven path and dug in from there to take over and draw clear late yards. JUST A SHEIKH settled back toward mid track, bid leaving the five sixteenths pole, steadied behind horses past the quarter, resumed her drive five wide at the head of the lane and got place the final stride. FLAVORED PUNCH settled close off the rail, surged to the lead three wide approaching the five sixteenths pole, widened that margin through the final turn but was caught late while leveling off. ROUGH TIME saved ground off the early pace, moved to the outside leaving the opening turn, bid from the three eighths pole, rounded the final turn five wide then leveled out inside the sixteenth pole. DIXIE GENT settled off the pace about the four path, bid past the three eighths pole but leveled off down the lane. SIGNATURE RUN, well back toward mid track, bid leaving the three eighths pole, saved ground on the final turn and leveled off in the lane. IDE BE A WHO DAT raced with the pace inside, came under pressure leaving the three eighths pole then faded past the five sixteenths. SALTY EMPEROR awkward at the break, raced with the pace two deep, came under pressure at the three eighths pole but started to fade nearing the five sixteenths. SLEWS ROYAL GOLD was not a factor. MCKENZIE CROSSING saved ground off the early pace then faded leaving the opening turn.
