SNABB FLICA , along the rail entering the turn, eased out to the three path entering the stretch, split foes in midstretch and narrowly prevailed. CONSOLIDATED GOLD chased the pace, raced in the three path leaving the turn, drifted four wide near the eighth pole and closed the gap late. SULTRYEYESFORU hopped at the break, chased the pace four wide on the turn, floated to the five path near the furlong marker and finished gamely. IT'S TIME TO WIN disputed the pace two wide and weakened late. COULD BE A RUMOR , in the two path near the eighth pole, failed to rally. QUICKETIA passed tired foes. NATALIE JANE , very wide leaving the turn, was not a factor. PRAISE DIXIE saved ground, dueled to the eighth pole then faltered. ISLAND MEMORIES hesitated at the break then was outrun. RIVER WALTZ reared at the break, unseating her rider.
