Footnotes

CHIGGER ROO, driven to the front to settle near the rail, was rated to the middle of the final turn, pressured from that point and widened under a steady drive. ALL MYSELF rated close inside, bid leaving the three eighths pole, was not a match for the winner but dueled for, and just lasted in, place. SINGIN THE BLUES, well back off the rail, bid toward the three eighths pole, eased to the three path through the upper stretch, got up for show under the wire and just missed place. TODAY AND ALWAYS stalked the early pace off the rail, gave chase from the quarter pole then leveled off in the stretch. BLUES IN THE NIGHT rated back toward the outside, bid leaving the half mile pole then faded from the top of the lane. DARTH TATER lunged and was checked at the break, settled off the pace about the four path, checked again from a diminishing hole nearing the final turn and had nothing further. LONG SHADOW raced well back inside.
