Footnotes

TOREADOR prompted the pace three wide around the first turn, sprinted to a long lead on the backstretch and was kept to his business in the stretch. NINJA NEKIA drifted out leaving the starting gate, advanced in the three path leaving the backstretch and continued to close the gap through the stretch. PROSPECT BREWING had speed along the rail on the first turn, drifted out near the three eighths pole, drifted wide near the eighth pole and finished willingly. MAYFEVER saved ground on the far turn and was not a threat. HE'S A WONDER drifted out leaving the starting gate, raced wide on the turns and was not a factor. DIXIE WHISKEY stalked the pace racing off the rail and faltered on the far turn. SURPRISEDTOSEEME , pinched back leaving the starting gate, was outrun. BOOSHEBA , wide the first turn, was outrun. PICK A TIZZY bobbled at the break and was outrun. SHAMROCK JIMMY prompted the pace two wide between horses on the first turn and faltered leaving the backstretch.
