Footnotes

MURJAN stalked the pace three wide, took aim leaving the half mile pole, was urged to the front at the quarter, dueled clear through the upper stretch and widened the final sixteenth. WORKING MAN BLUES settled back toward mid track, made an outside bid leaving the three eighths pole, rounded the final turn four wide and steadily improved to get place the closing yards. LONDON TOWN angled to the outside rounding the first turn, gave chase widest most of the backstretch, saved some ground on the final turn and got up late for show while unfinished for place. ACADEMY RUN rated close toward the inside, challenged leaving the seven sixteenths pole, dueled to a slim brief lead approaching the five sixteenths pole, relinquished control into the final turn but remained a close factor to midstretch before giving way. GENTLEMAN JOHN rated close off the rail, gave chase from the three eighths pole but faded on the final turn. BURNT OFFERING rated close to the early pace about the four path then showed no response from the half mile pole. ROYAL ZONE moved clear to save ground, rated a short lead to the seven sixteenths pole, was pressured past the pole, caught at the three eighths then faded through the final turn.
