Footnotes

WHITE POST settled off the pace off the rail, bid nearing the quarter pole, took over inside into the lane and dug in under a steady drive to last. NEW MILLENNIUM stalked the pace four wide, rallied to the front at the quarter pole, drifted outward leaving the final turn then came back to finish well at the outside flank of the winner. VALUED TRUST, a step slow to break, was rated back toward the outside, advanced from the three eighths pole, had aim four wide on the final turn, was carried widest into the lane though finished well when straightened away. FALSE DILEMMA, forced outward at the start, settled unhurried early on, bid off the rail at the three eighths pole, closed steadily rounding the final turn but leveled off through the lane. WILLIE'S WAY stalked the pace three wide, came under a drive from the five sixteenths pole but lacked further on the final turn. HUNTER MILL saved ground while off the pace and had no rally. MR. EDDINGTON came out at the break, rated a short early lead inside, yielded control into the backstretch, dueled to recover the advantage nearing the quarter pole but showed nothing further through the turn. LITTLE AFLEET was not a factor. DAVID'S TESTAMONY was pinched back early and not a factor. READY THE CONFETTI moved to the front leaving the first turn, was rated to the three eighths pole then gave way on the final turn.
