Footnotes

BORREGO'S BOY checked in tight near the rail entering the first turn, rated just off the pace two deep, bid from the five sixteenths pole, had aim nearing the quarter, dug in for the lead midstretch and inched clear toward the wire. SILKEN MANNER saved ground into the first turn, rated a short lead inside, came under pressure from the quarter pole, dug in with the advantage to midstretch though reluctantly yielded nearing the wire. APRIL'S FOIL stalked the pace three wide, was pressured from the five sixteenths pole, drifted slightly outward on the final turn, entered the lane in the five path and leveled off from there. KAUFY DREAMMACHINE, shut off into the first turn, rated close inside, took aim nearing the final turn but leveled off in the stretch. IN CONFIDENCE was outrun in an even effort. GOLD GLOVE appeared to be washed out in the post parade, rated off the early pace toward mid track, was under a drive from the three eighths pole then weakened in the stretch. C J'S AWAKENING, STONE DANCER and MILKSHADES'N ROSES were all not factors.
