SECRETLESS stalked the early pace, angled out for the stretch drive and drew off while in hand. PRIORITIES CHANGE speed, pressed pace, led, no match as a game second. PLEASURE IN TIME evenly, middle of pack, angled four wide and was willing when asked for his bid. BUSY MARIE no speed early, then responded to gain ground but was not a serious threat. POWER CROSSING well placed, chased but lacked the needed rally to finish evenly. LUCKY NELL no speed, second flight, had a mild gain when roused but was not a factor. TOM'S FIRST no speed, saved ground, showed little, no factor. CROWN PROOF away alertly, angled in to duel then weakened. DEEP IN DEPT broke late was never in contention and distanced.
