HE'S A PRIZE well placed from the outside, advanced entering the turn, responded and was getting to the winner. LYNN'S BEASTIE dueled from the inside for the early lead, remained engaged through the turn but could not keep pace. FREDDY BEAR went evenly. LITE THE HARBOR dueled from the inside and tired. SUGAR BEAR DIAMOND broke poorly from between foes, was squeezed back and outrun and vanned off after the race.
