HOLY STONE well placed from the inside, crept closer entering the second turn, gained command entering the drive and steadily drew clear under steady urging. E Z DAISY stalked the early pace from the inside, advanced entering the second turn, altered outside for the drive but could only gain the place. PERFECTABLE up close early from the outside, remained forward entering the second turn but could not keep pace through the drive. MARK TO MARKET went evenly. TIZ BOLD chased the early pace from the outside and tired. QUIET ILLUSION was no factor. CASSILDA was no threat. ONE SWEET TART was always outrun.
