Footnotes

HIDDEN CANYON stumbled a stride out, recovered and took over under a little encouragement under the wire the first time, dropped in when clear to set a rated pace, moved away when called upon around the final turn and was kept to solid hand encouragement. DANCIN N' DEALIN held a brief early advantage, stalked the winner while saving ground, continued along the rail into the lane and kept on gamely to the wire. AUGUST OSAGE, three wide into the first turn, chased between rivals from the far turn to upper stretch and continued willingly to earn a piece of the show. TITAN ALEXANDER leaned in at the break then bobbed to be away slowly, was sent up four wide to contention approaching the first turn, chased three wide outside rivals from the far turn to the head of the lane the finished with interest to be on even terms with AUGUST OSAGE. NO OFFENCE lagged back, passed a tiring rival in the lane but never menace. GARDEN TAVERN was lightly steadied while saving ground near the half mile marker, angled out, pursued four wide into the stretch and gave way. CELTIC WONDER failed to menace. BLUE WILDCAT was difficult to load then unruly in the gate, steadied when a bit rank behind foes early, chased off the rail for a half and faltered.
