FLASHY BOO set the pace on the rail, dug in through the stretch while all out to last. AWESOME ACTOR pressed the issue outside the winner and was slowly gaining in the drive. ISLAND SKY stalked the leaders five wide, finished strongly. ONE GOLDEN MINUTE prompted the pace three and four wide, lacked a late response. INFELD sluggish at the start and rank, rushed up along the inside but lacked a closing bid. GERRYMANDER three and four wide, lacked the needed rally. IRON MAN SURPRISE well placed along the inside, had no rally when asked. FOGIE saved ground to no avail. GATEWAY MOON with the pace three and four wide, stopped after a half.
