HASTA LA PASTA moved up three wide, made a clear lead on the turn, drew off through the stretch under a drive. MISS FASHION pressed the issue from the rail and while unable to threaten the winner was easily second best. KINISHA advanced along the rail to become a factor, was no match for the top two in the drive. GLASGOW ROAD bumped at the start, passed tiring rivals four wide. HOT ALLIANCE five and six wide, failed to menace. GIBSY set the pace on the rail, gave way around the turn. IMALEXUS was used up after a half, three wide. WHATABABE prompted the issue from the inside, had little left after a half. NO MORE CHANCES off a step slow then bumped at the start, stopped after a half.
