Footnotes

CAPE SABLE chased the pace inside, moved to the front at the head of the lane by virtue of saving ground through the turn, dueled clear in the upper stretch and held on well under a steady drive. FORCE OF GRAVITY chased the pace about the three path, contested at a slight disadvantage while being carried outward on the turn but dug in at the head of the lane to get up for place. TETON PASS, pinched back on the chute, gave chase toward the outside down the backstretch, saved some ground through the turn and finished evenly to get up for show. SMOKEY FELLA moved to the front toward the half mile pole to set a clear pace, contested while bearing outward on the turn, yielded into the lane then leveled off the final yards. CALL ME SIR chased the early pace off the rail, moved toward mid track at the three eighths pole and finished evenly. UNTAMEABLE chased the early pace from the outside, moved to the rail rounding the turn and finished evenly.
