Footnotes

RUNWAY rushed to contention, tracked the pace two wide, moved to engage the leader leaving the far turn, kicked clear with three sixteenths remaining, drifted out to the center of the track and lasted. MOSE BOTTOM rated early, commenced a rail run leaving the three eighths pole, angled out mid way on the final turn then rallied towards the inside of the winner. WHO DAT DINI was brushed early, settled off the pace, drifted out five wide nearing the stretch and rallied. STABLEMATE bobbed at the break then steadied soon after, lagged back, advanced along the rail into the lane, eased out to split rivals and kept on willingly. LOST IN THE WOODS angled three wide the first turn, chased to the far turn, remained a prominent factor to the three sixteenths pole then faded. SWEETTALKIN MAGGIE , reluctant to load, was sent three wide and cleared with five furlongs to go, angled to the rail, set the pace to the quarter pole then weakened. C M'S QUIETANN , three wide both turns, failed to menace. DENALI PIROUETTE , four wide the first turn, lugged in leaving the half mile marker and stopped.
