Footnotes

SOUND AFFAIR rated just off the pace off the rail, lacked room through the final turn, bid at the rail entering the stretch, dueled to the front a sixteenth away and inched clear toward the wire. PREMIER'S WHINNY rated off the pace in the four path, bid nearing the quarter pole, dueled to even terms past the three sixteenths and though turned back from midstretch, finished well at the winner's outside flank. ME LITTLE ACT rated close about the three path, bid nearing the quarter pole but flattened out midstretch. AFFIRMED STAR rated a clear lead inside, was pressured into the final turn, dueled with a slim lead in the upper stretch then weakened the final sixteenth. LOVE TO SHOOT OUT, fractious leaving the paddock, showed no speed in mid track then only a mild outside bid on the final turn. GENERAL RUTLEDGE, off the pace inside, gave chase past the three eighths pole and had little left on the final turn. POSITIVELY MACHO settled back from the early pace outside, saved ground through the final turn and had no rally. NO SUCH THING, six wide the opening turn, was not a factor. HO HUM HO was through early.
