Footnotes

BUCKSTON CALLING settled off the early pace inside, improved his position through the backstretch, eased outside of the pacesetting runner-up leaving the final turn and dug in determinedly to get up late yards. MARQUEE KISSES was hustled clear into the first turn, rated the pace inside down the backstretch, came under pressure nearing the quarter pole and dug in to the winner's challenge through the lane before reluctantly ceding the final yards. FIRSTIE moved to the outside leaving the first turn, settled well back early, bid from the five sixteenths pole, was forced nine wide past the three sixteenths, finished best and just missed place. PEACE MARCH rated close off the rail, gave chase down the backstretch, drifted to the six path leaving the three sixteenths pole and finished evenly. DRESSED UP rated off the pace about the three path, showed little response through the backstretch, entered the stretch seven wide and finished evenly. BLACK TIE DINNER was outrun while saving ground. WOODYS A GOODIE angled outward into the first turn, rated off the pace outside, was eight wide into the stretch and empty from that point. POSTMAN PETE, in tight early, settled well back off the rail, bid from the quarter pole then weakened in the stretch. TOP CAT DIAMOND was not a factor. IMYOURHUCKLEBERRY was carried out entering the first turn and never factored.
