SAVE A FAVOR saved ground, bid three wide around the turn then was up in the final strides. OCEAN JET moved up the rail, gained a slim lead in the upper stretch then in a long drive, just missed. GOLDIES HALF moved up the rail around the turn to be best of the rest. SNOBBY CURL stalked the pace four wide, failed to respond. MISS SWEDAUS passed tiring rivals, four wide. DREAD THAT ALARM set the pace for a half, gave way on the turn. CORDESIAN failed to menace. CLASSICAL'S FIRST hard used, tired. SILVER STAR flashed early speed, tired. EXPLOSEFA stopped after a half and was not abused in the stretch.
