UNLIKELY HERO hustled to the front for inside position, rated to the top of the stretch and drew off with a single tap to win easily. SPORTS BAR chased the winner two deep through the backstretch, rounded the turn at the rail and just lasted in place. WAR LION gave chase from well back, improved position while eased to mid track, came through the turn five wide and just missed place. UNBRIDLED BATTLE showed no early speed well back and off the rail, angled widest through the turn and finished evenly. PERFECT WAY gave chase three wide and had nothing further in the lane. JOE THE PLUMBER chased the pace from well back toward the outside, saved ground through the turn and proved empty in the lane. HELLO HOLLYWOOD, a step slow to break, showed no speed while saving ground. SIR FRANK chased the pace inside and checked at the rail near the five sixteenths pole. ACT OF DOMINANCE gave early chase two deep while between horses then gave way. GIBSON'S ATTITUDE had a brief early lead three wide then faded from the five sixteenths pole.
