R E LEE rated close off the rail, moved to the front past the three eighths pole, was pressured from the quarter and held well with steady encouragement. STOP THE BULL settled back off the rail, bid leaving the seven sixteenths pole, improved his position through the final turn but couldn't gain significantly on the winner. JENNY'S EARTHQUAKE rated a slim lead inside, was pressured nearing the seven sixteenths pole, gave chase from that point, relinquished control nearing the three eighths pole then dropped back on the final turn and leveled off down the lane. FROG TOWN ROAD steadied near the rail into the first turn, settled back inside, started a bid at the three eighths pole but showed little further in the stretch. DEUTERIUM, SAVASTEP and SUPREME NOTION were all outrun. PRUFROCK was not a factor. EXHORTER started bucking a sixteenth from the gate and pulled up on the first turn.
