Footnotes

EARLY STAR rated off the pace in the clear in the two path around the first turn, eased outside to edge closer down the backstretch, rallied four wide around the far turn, took command in upper stretch and drove clear. WINGED HERO brushed with PEACEFUL BLISS just after the start, prompted the pace three wide around the first turn, steadied nearing the nine-sixteenths pole, stalked the pace inside down the backstretch and around the far turn, angled out in upper stretch and rallied for second. EVIL COMMANDER set the pace off the rail around the first turn, angled to the rail entering the far turn, was collared in upper stretch and held well enough to preserve the show. PEACEFUL BLISS advanced four wide around the first turn to press the pace outside of EVIL COMMANDER down the backstretch, took the lead near the three-sixteenths pole, vied between rivals in upper stretch then gave way approaching the sixteenth pole. ETCHED IN STONE went evenly in the two path and was vanned off. STRAIGHT THUNDER saved ground early, was wide around the far turn and was never a factor. FRISKIE J trailed while racing three and four wide.
