Footnotes

MAKIN BOND rated a short lead inside, was pressured toward the three sixteenths pole, drifted outward in the upper stretch but dug in to widen when straightened away. CAUTION HIGH WATER, well back toward mid track, bid leaving the three eighths pole, was shut off and checked at the heels of the bolting Downbytheriver past the three sixteenths pole, angled to the rail at the top of the stretch and dueled late for place. LAGI LAGI stalked the pace about the three path, bid leaving the five sixteenths pole but was outfinished in the duel for place. GOT THE URGE rated with the pace two deep, gave chase from the five sixteenths pole but dropped back through the final turn and leveled off down the lane. NICO SQIZZ raced well back saving ground. MR BALBOA was roughed when boxed at the heels of rivals through the opening turn then faded down the backstretch. DOWNBYTHERIVER's rider lost his right iron soon after the break, recovered that iron to give chase from the seven sixteenths pole but bolted past the three sixteenths pole and lost his rider in the process. The stewards posted an inquiry before declaring this race official.
