OL' MAN MURPH broke alertly, angled to the rail to set the pace, prevailed under urging. ALLEN'S MONSTER pressed the issue three wide and was slowly gaining in the drive. WHYKNOTTFORME advanced three and four wide, lacked a closing bid. JAYDEN'S DREAM broke awkwardly, stalked the leaders three and four wide but lacked a late bid. SEITA MEZZ found his best stride late along the rail. COUNTY TIME forced the pace from the inside, eased out four wide on the turn, never threatened in the drive. BRASSY SELF five wide along the backstretch, came seven wide around the turn while no threat. CLOSER TO PEACE up close early, steadily fell back. GREAT ISLANDER six wide down the backstretch, was no factor.
