FREE JUICE set the pace on the inside, held clear throughout and prevailed while kept to strong urging. OZILDA'S KAREN bobbed at the start, saved ground, angled out for the drive and finished strongly. OLYMPIC NIGHT lugged out and bumped with SILVR TRICON into the first turn, stalked the pace four wide, had no late bid. RICO ENDS WELL moved up five wide, closed willingly. NASTY SABRINA off slow, saved ground to no avail. MISS HAMMA reared at the start, was bumped and forced out around the first turn, rushed up down the backstretch but flattened out. UNIQUE TECHNIQUE prompted the pace three wide, gave way on the turn. CEDAR RUNS CASE showed little three wide. DOLLY'S WAGER close up inside, had little left for the drive. SILVER TRICON bobbed at the start then was bumped and forced out into the first turn and was used up after a half.
