Footnotes

BACA advanced five wide, gained the lead nearing the sixteenth pole and drew well clear. T. V. SECRETARY sluggish at the start, moved up four wide, gained the lead in the upper stretch but was out finished. FINISH 'EM OFF stalked the pace four wide, failed to respond. ONESTEP rallied six wide around the turn but was too late. STORMIN' DOWN prompted the pace just off the rail, lacked a late response. LILY OF THE VALLEY set the pace under heavy pressure inside, weakened in the drive. DOLLY'S WAGER pressed the pace three wide, lacked a late ally. CASTELLI'S GYPSY was used up after a half three wide.
