NAVY DAME stalked the early pace from the inside, inched closer entering the second turn, altered outside for the drive and finished well. CREATIVE ROSETTA chased the early pace from the inside, made a bid entering the drive but was no match late. TUFTIKUS dueled from the inside and tired. SAINT ZITA was no factor. BOUGH BREAKER was no threat. DEVON TRYST was always outrun.
