Footnotes

BUZZ dueled from the inside for the early lead, remained engaged up the backstretch with JOYFUL KISS, put that one away entering the drive, opened a clear margin at the eighth pole and was clear late under steady urging. BLUFF THE WEATHER unhurried early, dropped back entering the second turn, responded to advance up the backstretch, altered outside entering the third turn, split rivals entering the drive and was gaining late. SPEEDY TUXEDO stalked the early pace from the inside, inched closer entering the backstretch, responded when asked entering the drive but could not keep pace. I GOT'M allowed to settle early, steadily advanced up the backstretch, responded to pressure and finished well but too late. YELLOW BRICK BANK went evenly. LIVELY REPARATIONS could only pass tired ones. JOYFUL KISS dueled from the outside and tired. MILL STONE had little interest. ROCK PICKER was finished after going a half.
