Footnotes

BUY OUT was acting up a bit in the gate just prior to the start, came away a tad slow then steadied when in close soon after, bumped with a rival while saving ground into the first turn, began making progress leaving the five sixteenths marker, quickly reached contention mid way on the final turn, surged through a seam along the rail in upper stretch, took over a sixteenth out and pulled away under right handed encouragement. CORINTHIAN QUEST tracked a contested early pace while saving ground, shifted out three wide around the final turn, ranged up to threaten in mid stretch, kept on willingly but was no match for the winner. ROBB'S WARRIOR set a pressured pace towards the rail, shook clear leaving the far turn, drifted off the fence entering the stretch, held well to the sixteenth pole then faded. DR CLOSE CALL , between rivals the first turn while close up, was sent three wide to threaten after a half mile, gave wider chase into the lane and stayed on willingly. CHEROKEE CARL saved ground for nearly a half mile, altered three wide mid way on the final turn then had belated interest between rivals. SPUR TREE , four wide in range, made a slight move nearing the lane then failed to sustain. KID COTTON came out at the break, was taken to rate and failed to menace. FORTY WINKS , wide, was not a factor. TUFF ACTION was sent up early, disputed the pace two wide to the far turn then gave way. DUG BAR bumped with the winner nearing the first turn, lagged back saving ground and was outrun.
