DELAWARE TWO STEP broke alertly, set all the pace, widened under urging. PIESAFE advanced along the inside, bid three wide around the turn to be second best. MAGICAL CREEK forced the issue three wide, rallied around the turn but was no match for the winner. AMBER'S LEGEND prompted the leaders along the rail, lacked a late response. EAST LONDON pressed the pace just off the rail, lacked a closing bid. ICY PROSPECT off slow, passed tiring rivals. MILLENNIUM RUSH never was a factor, four wide. DIAMOND ANGEL flashed brief foot, five wide. CONNIE MED never threatened, five wide. MOTLEY BIRD showed early speed four wide, tired.
