Footnotes

BROTHER BRADEN rated just off the early pace inside, started a bid leaving the three eighths pole, eased three wide through the final turn, dueled to the front nearing midstretch and edged clear past the sixteenth pole. CHRIS'S SYMPHONY took the lead inside to set the pace, rated an edge from the five sixteenths pole, contested a slim advantage rounding the final turn, was caught midstretch and yielded past the sixteenth pole. BLACK TIE DINNER stalked the pace off the rail, held aim leaving the second turn, gave close chase down the backstretch, contested at a slight disadvantage through the final turn but dropped back into the lane and leveled off from there. WHITE POST rated just off the pace about the three path, gave chase past the three eighths pole, saved some ground on the final turn, eased four wide entering the stretch and finished evenly. CAROLINE'S DANCER rated off the pace about the three path then lacked a significant response at the rail down the backstretch. HIDDEN SOURCE kept off the pace and off the rail, moved out with a mild bid leaving the second turn but leveled off on the final turn. BLACK TIE BOOGIE, off the pace inside, was not a factor. ALEX A FORTIORI dropped well back and was not a factor.
